Definition: A SANCTIONED TRIAL is an event that follows OSDS requirements.

Requirements for Trial Sanctioning:

1. The trial must be open to all OSDS members on an equal opportunity basis (note that it is not mandatory to offer all classes).
2. Entry forms must be published by OSDS in the newsletter or on the website.
3. The opening date for entries and the closing date should be clearly listed.
4. Follow OSDS class definitions. If you plan to run to a standard this should also be stated on the entry form.
5. Follow ISDS or USBCHA rule book.
6. Limited Sheepdog Trials must allow a minimum of 40 teams to enter. Cattledog Trials must allow a minimum of 20 teams to enter.
7. Results must be sent to point secretary within 14 days after trial.
8. Clearly state on the entry form that the trial is 'OSDS Sanctioned'.
9. Points year runs from August 1 through July 31.
